HOW TO USE THIS INFORMATION

Your employees in private practice are entitled to a minimum wage. This is the lowest amount that they can be paid for the work they are doing. The minimum wage refers to the amount of pay before tax is taken out (gross pay).

We have prepared this guide to provide you with handy access to selected minimum rates of pay for health professional employees under the **Health Professionals and Support Services Award 2020 (Award)**. The minimum wages in this guide apply from the first full pay period on or after 1 July 2022.

This guide is a summary of selected information only. We have included the minimum rates of pay that are most frequently requested by our members. The minimum rates of pay in this guide do not represent the full list of minimum wages in the Award and do not extend to all employers and employees covered by this Award.

For a complete list of minimum wages under the Award, please refer to the Fair Work Ombudsman's **pay guides**. For full terms and conditions, please refer to the **Award** itself.
